The General Account budget for this year was \$53,430 and total expense, as of October 31, 2022, we have spent \$28,298.31 so far. There are several budget categories, so far, that have little or no expenditures but that will change shortly.

We are forecasting a net income of approximately \$8,500.

The Charity Account budget was approved for \$147,330.00 and year to date expenditures, as of October 31, 2022, are \$21,712.78 with many expenditures to come such as Hoop Shoot, and Scholarships.

The balance of the Investment Account is \$227,744.65.

We have also been establishing some guidelines for the Investment Account. We should have them finalized by the Annual Meeting in April 2023.

Prospectus for Nevada State Booth at Grand Lodge

Reasoning: We have had a good relationship in the past with our present state major project, St. Jude's Ranch. A booth at the Grand Lodge Convention will help the state and the Ranch in two ways:

- 1. Show how we, both entities, are investing in the youth of our country
- 2. Get us some much needed, and deserved, recognition nationwide

Cost: Last year the cost of a booth in Atlanta was \$310. With inflation and transportation costs rising, this will probably raise. However, the overall cost should not be overbearing. The material needed to be displayed will be negligible because the pictures, brochures, information sheets will come from the Ranch. The initial cost of the banners for the booth will be defrayed over time because they will be used every year. We also have a site where we can get banners made relatively cheaply; usually about \$25 per banner. Transportation of material the first year will be nil because they will be going in the Dyer's vehicle. The year's after, shipping might be needed. New material can be gained each year from the Ranch. A raffle prize will be donated each year with proceeds going to both the state (to offset costs) and the Ranch. Several individuals have already offered to get nice raffle prizes.

Setting up and Manning: The physical booth will be done by the company Grand Lodge hires. Setting up the display will be done by people from Nevada who are at the convention. Several have already stated they will donate their time. ERs will be asked to man the booth like they are asked to man the hospitality room.

Committee Composition: The State President-elect will be the chairman. The chairmen of the Board of Directors and the State Major Project will be vice chairs. The rationale for this is that the President-elect will be the President at the convention. The two chairpeople will be from the entities where the money will come from and who deals with the people at the Ranch the most. The rest of the committee will be from the people who will be going to the convention. It will be a fluid committee in that it will change yearly, so good records must be maintained.
